Our 13<sup>th</sup> annual Firefly Trail Ticket to Ride bicycle event is coming up on Saturday, March 23, 2024. We hope you will join us as a sponsor! Ticket to Ride brings together 250 or more cyclists to raise funds and awareness for our non-profit's work to complete the 39-mile Firefly Trail from Athens to Union Point – or Union Point to Athens if you start from the south end. Ticket to Ride is one of the largest, non-competitive, mass participation rides in Northeast Georgia. It's an essential fundraiser for our 501(c)(3) organization, Firefly Trail, Inc.

Thanks to past support, we have been able to provide more than \$300,000 in matching funds to our trail communities. Those funds have made it possible for the communities to secure more than \$2.3 million in grants and build more than 8 miles of trail. With this history of success, we are gearing up for the biggest and best Ticket to Ride ever, featuring new segments of trail in Greene County and Woodville if they are open in time. Your sponsorship dollars help us to:

- Put on a first-class ride along completed sections of the trail and paved roads close to the historic corridor of the Georgia Railroad Union Point/Athens Branch.
- Cover the costs of our professional Trail Development Coordinator, whose commitment, knowledge and skills have advanced work on the trail by years.
- Continue to provide matching funds to attract grants that actually fund building the trail.

As always, we will have start/finish locations in Athens, Winterville, and Union Point, with opportunities for sponsors to put up their banners, provide items for riders, set up their tent and table, and ride with us (if you want to). Participants can tailor their ride to fit their time and ability, whether they want to go a few miles at an easy pace or hammer all 83 miles on the out-and-back course.
